1. Adoption of the FY24 Budget

The one change made in the budget since the last meeting is a reduction of \$7,000 in the Police Department's budget, a result of the department being fully staffed.

CAO Emily Woodmaster stated that once Baldwin receives the digest from the County, Council will begin discussions of the millage rate, which cannot be set without the digest. The City typically receives the digest in the beginning of July, but there is no estimated timeline.




